Solar energy Harvesting - Installed capacity; 350 KW-H

The power cultivated is connected to our grid power and as a result our diesel consumption goes down, reducing our carbon footprint.



RO Plant - Installed capacity; 2 units of 150 cubic meter/day and 1 unit of 50 cubic meter/day These plants have inbuilt energy recovery system to reduce the energy consumption.



Waste waters are organically treated in our state of the art organic sewage treatment plant where treated water is being used for irrigation and gardening purpose and rest gets recycled back in the plant and the cycle continues.



Heat Exchangers for hot water supply to whole island and for our laundry drier room. This reduces usage of electric water heaters and commercial dryers, instead the heat exchangers tagged along to the generators produce enough heat to supply hot water for the whole island.



Bio gas plant generates bio gas from nearly all of our daily food waste and this gas fuels our kitchens.



Usage of LED lights all over the resort as an energy conservation plan.



During construction, our team avoided cutting of trees. Bigger trees which were in area of construction were safely relocated. Mobilization of machinery which would harm corals in our lagoon were avoided and where required, they were relocated.



A combination of soil stabilized earthen blocks and aerated cement concrete block in creating our buildings. Both of these materials are eco-friendly materials, functioning as natural heat insulator and keeping carbon footprint as low as possible.
